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## The Program

The Mayor's Scholarship Fund was established to provide financial assistance to Idaho Falls area students who plan to pursue a post-secondary education or training. Funds for these scholarships are made possible through generous voluntary contributions from citizens, corporate and business sponsors. The Mayor's Scholarship Fund Promise Award is for students currently in **Grades 8 –11** who agree to maintain a college-bound path. These awards can be used at an approved accredited post-secondary school or training program within the state of **Idaho** or for US military education programs. The award may also be applied toward the cost of approved dual credit coursework or college preparation fees while still in high school. Recipient has until two years from high school graduation or equivalent to request funds.

## Eligibility

You must meet at least **one** of these requirements: 1) be a resident of Idaho Falls; or 2) attend school within the physical boundaries of Idaho Falls District 91 or Bonneville School District 93.

## Application

To apply, students must submit the following in duplicate: (original and one copy)  
A completed application form with applicant & parent or guardian signature including:

- Personal Information sheet
- Activities Sheet
- Personal Essay
- Signed Letter of Recommendation

## Application Deadline

Applications are **due Wednesday, February 4, 2026** They may be submitted to a college and career advisor or school counselor no later than the close of school that day. Applications may also be mailed to:

Mail-in applications must be received by 4:00pm on the deadline date.

## Selection of Recipients

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the basis of information supplied. Emphasis will be placed upon student GPA, school/community involvement, citizenship, and future promise. The scoring rubric weights applicants with a GPA of 3.0-3.5 with the highest points possible. Incomplete applications will not be considered. All recipients will be notified of the results following our application evaluations in February. Award recipients are expected to attend all scholarship program events including a photo and video shoot in March as well as a recipient reception and awards ceremony in April.
